## Wine Features

### Los Monteros Cava Brut

Maybe you've never really been that into sparkling wines before. That's about to change. This luscious Cava has the most inviting aroma of savory herbs and lemon; not parsley and sage but definitely some rosemary and thyme. A palette dominated by big green apples is balanced by bubble-enhanced acids to keep you going back again and again.

### Jean-Marc Brocard Chablis Sainte Claire

This one really makes me wish we had a raw bar. The nose is classic Chablis gunflint. The palate opens to a rounder slightly fruitier expression like bright yellow lemons chasing the liquor of freshly shucked oysters.

### Pic and Chapoutier Côtes du Rhône Rouge

Born of a collaboration between Chef Anne-Sophie Pic and winemaker Michel Chapoutier, this Syrah and Grenache blend needs to be enjoyed with some excellent food. Firm yet silky, the wine is complex with notes of sour cherries, licorice and black pepper.

### Les Volets Pinot Noir Haute Vallée de l'Aude

Deep in the south of France, the grapes for this pinot basked in warm Mediterranean days and cool Pyrenean nights before being handpicked for this delicious example of terroir. Ripe summer strawberries work harmoniously with an oaky backbone and some very nice tannins.
